CAPE TO CAPE MTB 2009 – OFFICIAL RESULTS

More than 200 mountain bike riders are feeling sore and sorry after traversing over 220km in the second annual Cape to Cape MTB event held in the Margaret River region over the weekend. The field included some of the world's best, riding alongside recreational riders from all over Australia.

2008 World 24 hour solo champion James Williamson battled it out with longtime rival Rohin Adams and eventually came out on top in a battle waged through Yelverton Forrest. Williamson completed the four day event in 9 hours, 17 minutes and 46 seconds. Former female world champion Niki Fisher took out the female Elite title in a time of 10:54:03 over the four days.

Sixteen year old Dunsborough local Rowan Brown kept up with the elite riders all the way and pulled off a massive upset to win Stage 4 honours from Margaret River to Yallingup.
